After approaching 1,000+ businesses about staffing, an idea sparked.

So in 2018, Stint was born.

What began as a small group of students helping people find short shifts over WhatsApp, snowballed into a groundbreaking app that has now connected over 250,000 people to hundreds of top brands in hospitality for flexible part-time work.

How does Stint work?


Moving onto hospitality...

These short peaks aren't a sufficient shift length for most members of staff, resulting in **overstaffing** and **understaffing** throughout the day, which impacts customer service.





Stint Teams work just the hours necessary.


